Signing in/out Books for Pupils

Safeguarding is a crucial part of our daily care for your child. We are finding that often pupils arrive late without an adult, or an explanation as to why they are late. This will need to be signed by whoever accompanies your child when they are brought to school giving the reason for their lateness.
