IMPORTANT CHANGES FROM NEXT HALF TERM

When we return after the half term break on 30th October there will be a number of changes in school:

- The school day will finish at 3:10pm instead of 3:20pm. The children will still have the same amount of learning time, lunch will be shortened by 10 minutes.
- School dinners will increase in price from £2.30 per day to £2.50 per day for Key Stage 2 children who are not entitled to free school meals. All children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 are entitled to universal free school meals. If your child is in year 3, 4, 5 or 6 you must either pay for school meals via SCOPAY or apply for free school meals on the Lancashire County Council Website: https://www.lancashire.gov.uk/children-education-families/schools/free-school-meals/
