

Pupil Premium Key Stage Two Results 2016

- The majority of pupils made at least expected progress.
- School tracking of targeted interventions has been implemented (September 2016) so that impact can be measured.
- Key Stage 2 results for 2016 indicate that of the 11 pupils eligible for Pupil Premium in this cohort 73% made expected progress in Reading and Writing and 82% made the expected progress in Maths.
