### Story time

This week our theme is something a lot of the children have enjoyed incorporating into their play recently – pirates!

Listen out for the word “stealthy”, which means you do something or move very carefully without being seen or heard!  
Can you give an example of moving stealthily?

The story says “As stealthy as shadows”. Perhaps you could have a try at making some shadows!

### Treasure hunt!

Pirate love to hunt for treasure. Can you find the following?

- 5 items which are red?
- 3 items which are blue?
- 2 items which are green?

Talk with your child about where they found the items. How many are there altogether? Are there different ways you could organise your items? For example, order them largest to smallest? Shiny and not shiny?

If you would like to carry on playing, the children could hide an item and give you directions to try and find it!

Thank you to all for engaging with our home learning ideas. Please don't worry if you are unable to complete all of these or do different activities! The main things to keep doing are reading, talking as much as possible and singing your favourite songs and rhymes. Numberblocks and Alphablocks are good educational programmes to watch at home to support development.
