Story time

Today we carry on with our pirate theme.

Listen to the story Pirates Love Underpants! here:

Listen out for the word “quest”. A quest is a long and difficult search to find something! What were the pirates on a quest for?

What things did the pirates have to get past on their quest?

You could role play your own pirate quest – what are you going on a quest to find? What might you find on the way and how will you get past it?

Crocodiles?! A gloopy, sticky swamp that you need to wade through? How will you get over the flowing, rapid river?!

Floating and sinking

Using a bowl of water, or any container (this includes your bath or sink!) use some different objects and explore the concepts of floating and sinking.

Encourage your child to talk about what they observe and ask lots of questions. Why do some float and some sink? Do some sink faster or slower? Are they heavy or light?

Thank you to all for engaging with our home learning ideas. Please don't worry if you are unable to complete all of these or do different activities!

The main things to keep doing each day are reading, talking, counting as much as possible and singing your favourite songs and rhymes.

Numberblocks and Alphablocks are good educational programmes to watch at home to support development in number and sounds.

Phonics play is also free currently. In nursery we focus on Phase 1:

What am I? (Communication and Language)

To continue with our theme you could use some sea animal photographs or pirate themed items. However any items can be used for this for example toy animals, sponges, household items.

Ask children to describe an item to the other person to try and guess! For example my item is a SHARK. It lives in the sea, it can be large or small, it has very sharp teeth, his skin is grey, he is a predator! (A good opportunity for introducing vocabulary!)

You could even turn this into a small competition.
