Wind Chime

Wind chimes make lovely noise when it is windy outside. Collect some different items – spoons, buttons, string, tin cans... anything you like which makes different sounds. Experiment making sounds by hitting the items together.

Now try to create your own unique wind chime to listen to in the day if it is windy!

Phase 1 Phonics: Body Percussion

Listen to some different songs today. Try to clap along in time to the beat of the song – this can be trickier than it sounds and is a great skill to practise rhythm. Good luck!
