### Nature Detectives

Have a look around the environment either outside your home or on a walk. What signs of wildlife can you find?

You can count or draw a picture of some of the thing you see. Some signs of wildlife to look out for are:

- Nests
- Feathers
- Spider webs
- Slug or snail slime
- Holes or dens
- Insect or animal poo
- Half-eaten leaves, nuts or berries
- Mole hills

### The number one!

What does the number one look like? Can you draw it in the air?
